They live with their 3 children in a cottage in the grounds of Windsor Castle.



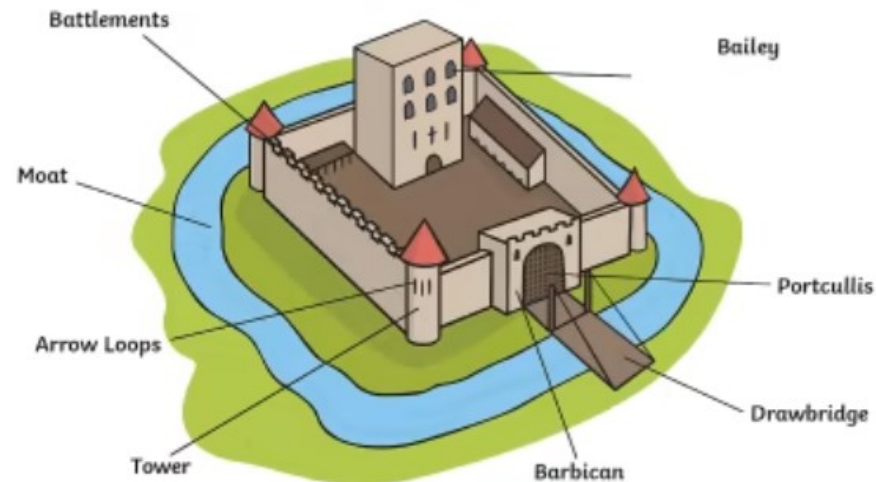
Where are Castles built?

Castles are normally built high up, on a hill so they can see all of the surrounding area. This means they can see if people are coming to attack the Castle. They are often built near water so that food and things they need are easily accessed. A moat also provides extra protection and defence for attackers.
